Bring together a generation of young professionals within a passionate community that thrives in the infrastructure sector


Initiate a discussion on the many challenges and developments in the sector to foster the emergence of new recommendations and practices




Evolution of LinkedIn subscribers since 2019





FIRST TRAINING PROGRAM

- We launched the **first edition** of our **training program**, which brought together **experts from our sponsors and motivated participants**. - Infravenir was in Strasbourg in April 2024, a day full of discoveries and discussions where our members had the chance to:

The discussions ended with a visit to the biomass and gas heating plant at the Lycée Le Corbusier.

THE GROWING COMMUNITY IN LONDON



- In 2024, Infravenir strengthened its presence in the UK and created an office with dedicated staff based in London.
 - In February, a first conference in partnership with our sponsor White & Case was organised on **carbon capture in the UK**.
 - A second conference, **What is ESG Finance today?**, in partnership with Linklaters, the Energy Institute Young Professionals Network London Branch and the Chartered Accountant Student Society of London, was attended by around a hundred London professionals.
 - In July and November, Infravenir's London members were able to meet up for an afterwork, which were marked by the presence of many new faces.

What's next?

The interest shown by members in the events organised in 2024 has demonstrated the relevance of a dedicated office in London. Infravenir therefore plans to continue organising events in 2025 to strengthen its presence in London.

THE GROWING COMMUNITY IN MADRID



Infravenir reinforces its presence in Madrid

- Buoyed by the success of Infravenir in London and the growing network in Spain, we have also continued to develop our activity in Madrid.
- A first conference on the theme of **energy transition: challenges and opportunities** was held in April at the offices of our sponsor White & Case.
- In September, our sponsor Clifford Chance hosted a second conference on **the outlook for telecommunications infrastructures**.
- Finally, a number of **afterwork** events were organised throughout the year, confirming the interest shown by Madrid residents in regular exchanges.

What's next?

In 2025, we want to consolidate this community around more frequent conferences and round tables, with renowned local speakers.

The set up of a dedicated local team to run more regular activity in Madrid is also expected.

LAUNCH OF OUR OFFICE IN MARSEILLE

Infravenir has strengthened its presence in France, particularly in Marseille

- In 2023, as part of its French Regions series, Infravenir met for a day in Marseille to:
 - discuss the attractiveness of the region with Rising Sud ;
 - visit the Captain Gèze retention basin managed by Artelia;
 - visit the Fabriques site, an eco-neighbourhood managed by Linkcity.
- Building on this success, Infravenir has chosen to bring on board Gautier Orlando and Adrien Oustric to set up a new office in the city.
- Marseille is our first office in France outside Paris where members have been able to meet up several times in 2024 for various events: an initial afterwork in April, a second in September and finally a round table on sustainable buildings last December.

What's next ?

In 2025, we want to consolidate our French community around various events outside Paris, and in particular plan to (i) consolidate our Marseille office, (ii) open a new one in Strasbourg, and (iii) depending on opportunities, continue our expansion by opening other French offices!

CONTINUED PUBLICATION OF **PODCAST**

- To stay connected with its community throughout the world and to allow its members to listen or listen again to the round tables, Infravenir is perpetuating its podcast channel in 2024! Infravenir podcast chanel *Les Rendez-Vous de l'Infra* aims to become a relevant resource, in line with everyone's daily rhythms, and to open up new content opportunities.
- Since its creation, Infravenir podcast had more than **3,800 listens**, at a rate of more than 100 per month, 62% of which are on Spotify, 22% on web browsers, 12% on Deezer and 4% on Google Podcasts and other platforms.
- With 17% of its listeners located outside of France, Infravenir podcasts international footprint is growing (with notably 3% in the USA and 2% in the UK).




- Year 2024 was also marked by some major changes to our communication channels:
