



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR THE GROWING COMMNITY IN LONDON







- In 2024, Infravenir strengthened its presence in the UK and created an office with dedicated staff based in London.
 - In February, a first conference in partnership with our sponsor White & Case was organised on carbon capture in the UK.
 - A second conference, What is ESG Finance today?, in partnership with LinkLaters, the Energy Institute Young Professionals Network London Branch and the Chartered Accountant Student Society of London, was attended by around a hundred London professionals.
 - > In July and November, Infravenir's London members were able to meet up for an afterwork, which were marked by the presence of many new faces.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

LAUNCH OF OUR OFFICE IN MARSEILLE

Infravenir has strengthened its presence in France, particularly in Marseille

- In 2023, as part of its French Regions series, Infravenir met for a day in Marseille to:
 - discuss the attractiveness of the region with Rising Sud;
 - visit the Captain Gèze retention basin managed by Artelia;
 - visit the Fabriques site, an eco-neighbourhood managed by Linkcity.
- Building on this success, Infravenir has chosen to bring on board Gautier Orlando and Adrien Oustric to set up a new office in the city.
- Marseille is our first office in France outside Paris where members have been able to meet up several times in 2024 for various events: an initial afterwork in April, a second in September and finally a round table on sustainable buildings last December.

What's next?

In 2025, we want to consolidate our French community around various events outside Paris, and in particular plan to (i) consolidate our Marseille office, (ii) open a new one in Strasbourg, and (iii) depending on opportunities, continue our expansion by opening other French offices!









CONTINUED PUBLICATION OF PODCAST

- To stay connected with its community throughout the world and to allow its members to listen or listen again to the round tables, Infravenir is perpetuating its podcast channel in 2024! Infravenir podcast channel Les Rendez-Vous de l'Infra aims to become a relevant resource, in line with everyone's daily rhythms, and to open up new content opportunities.
- Since its creation, Infravenir podcast had more than 3,800 listens, at a rate of more than 100 per month, 62% of which are on Spotify, 22% on web browsers, 12% on Deezer and 4% on Google Podcasts and other platforms.
- With 17% of its listeners located outside of France, Infravenir podcasts international footprint is growing (with notably 3% in the USA and 2% in the UK).

Continue to organise recurring events: on the energy transition, the Infraspiring series, our podcasts, etc., while continuing to internationalise the association by offering events in English in Paris (International series).

Launch the second edition of our mentoring programme. Proud of the success of the first edition, more than 50 mentees will be coached throughout 2025 by mentors whose experience and expertise are unquestionable.

Standardise Infravenir Training every two years: the training programme held in 2024, dedicated solely to the employees of our sponsors. This initiative was largely a victim of its own success!

Continuing Infravenir's growth! Both in France, such as Strasbourg, and internationally. Marseille, London and Madrid are examples of success we can learn from.

And all of this, while vibrating to the rhythm of our afterworks, these not-to-be-missed events that illuminate our ambitions by offering a privileged space for discussions and fellowship between our members! 2025 will also see the launch of thematic meetings bringing together the different passions that drive us: infrastructure, sports and music!
